**NOTICE FROM THE ROYAL FREE MRD LAB:** No one will be available in the MRD lab to receive samples during the Easter Bank Holidays – To be more precise the lab will cover the days the NHS hospitals are open, i.e; until 28<sup>th</sup> March and 2<sup>nd</sup> April onwards. Centres should make sure the lab receive samples before 28<sup>th</sup> March 5pm so as to avoid samples getting lost in post during Easter holidays. If you are unable to do this then the sample should be stored in a fridge until 2<sup>nd</sup> April and send via courier.

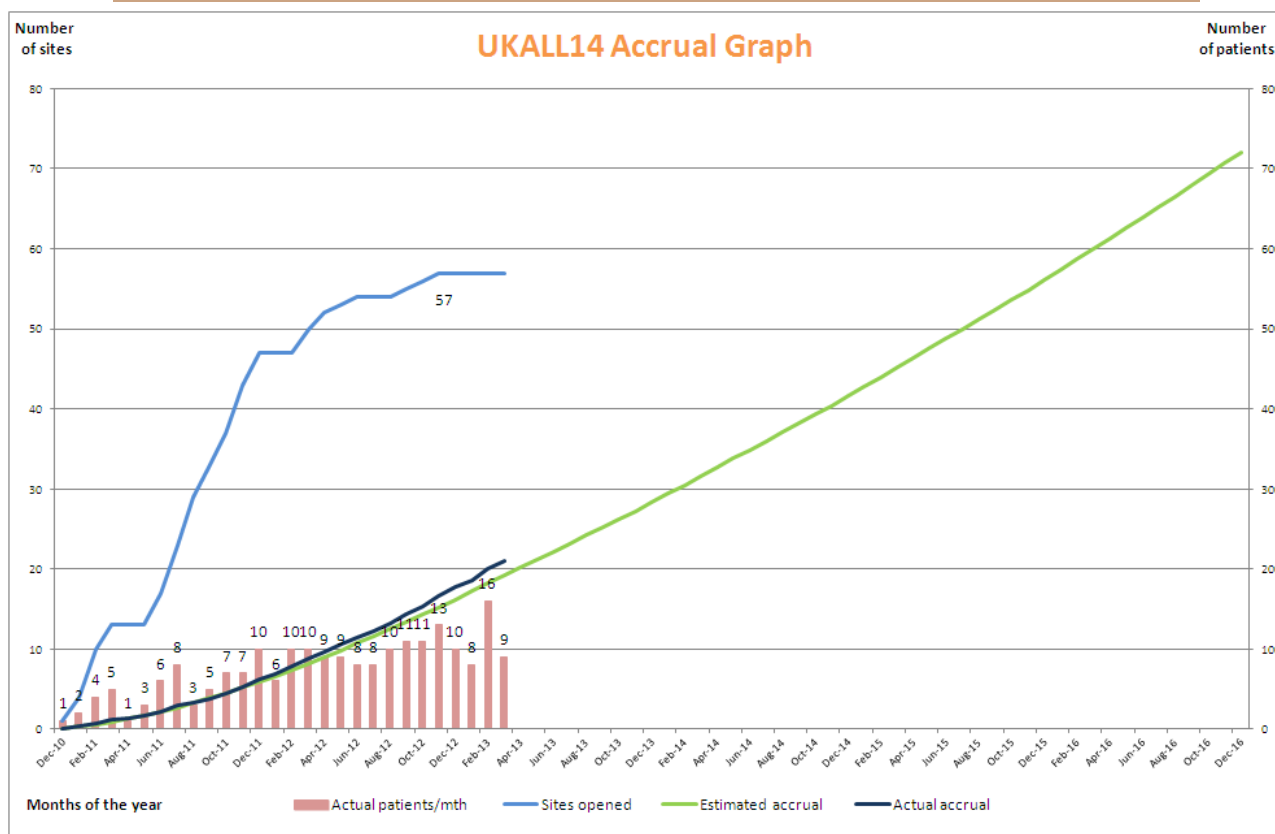

### **REMINDERS!!**

**CYTOGENETICS FORMS** – Please ensure that once you have a patient randomised onto UKALL14 you send the hard copy of the Cytogenetics CRF to the UCL Cancer Trials Centre within 2 weeks.

**CRFs** – Please send in the original CRFs for all your patients within one month of that phase of treatment being completed.

**ADVERSE EVENTS FORMS** – Please remember to complete an AE Form for each phase of your patient’s treatment and send these back with the relevant CRFs for that phase of treatment.

**PALIFERMIN PATIENTS – ORAL MUCOSITIS DAILY QUESTIONNAIRES (OMDQs)** – This is just a reminder to sites that have/will have patients allocated to a Myeloablative Transplant. Please make sure you administer the OMDQs as these form the Primary Endpoint for the Palifermin arm.
